



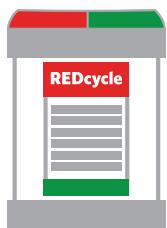
Did you know?

# Avoid • Reduce • Reuse • Recycle

For all councils in the Perth metropolitan area, the recycling rules have changed.  
Please use this guide to help you recycle right.

## Which bin do I put it in?

You should put these into your **yellow-topped bin**:



## These items **MUST NOT** go in your yellow-topped bin:

**NO items in bags**  
(recyclables should be placed loose in the bin)

**NO plastic bags and light plastic film**

**NO nappies**

**NO clothes or other textiles**

**NO food or garden waste**

**NO building waste**

**NO gas bottles, aerosols or batteries**

**NO ropes, cables and garden hose pipes**

**NO polystyrene or takeaway coffee cups**

**NO meat trays**

If in doubt, leave it out.

## Get to know your local Recycling Centre

The **West Metro Recycling Centre** provides a central point to drop-off recyclables and other materials which do not belong in your kerbside recycling or landfill bin.

### What can I drop off at the Recycling Centre?

- Problematic Waste (aerosols, gas bottles, mattresses, batteries)
- Household Hazardous Waste (chemicals, paint, household and lead-acid batteries)
- Clothing and Textiles
- Electronic Waste
- Greenwaste
- Compact Fluorescent Lights
- Cardboard

Some items can be disposed of free of charge and other items attract a small fee.
